HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION

The County of Lake is partnering with Quackenbush Mountain Resource Recovery and Compost Facility adjacent to East Lake Landfill, and with Lake County Waste Solutions Transfer Station in Lakeport, for monthly Household Hazardous Waste Collection sites. What Products are Acceptable at PaintCare Drop-Off Sites? What Products are Covered?

Architectural paints ("Program Products") are defined as interior and exterior architectural coatings sold in containers of 5 gallons or less. However, they do not include aerosol products (spray cans), industrial maintenance (IM), original equipment manufacturer (OEM), or specialty coatings. Here are examples:

Program Products (Acceptable)

- Interior and exterior architectural paints: latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, oil-based, enamel (including textured coatings)
- Deck coatings, floor paints (including elastomeric)
- Primers, sealers, undercoaters
- Stains
- Shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethanes (single component)
- Waterproofing concrete/masonry/wood sealers, metal coatings, rust preventatives and repellents (not tar or bitumen-based)
- Field and lawn paints

Non-Program Products (Not Acceptable)

- Paint thinners, mineral spirits, solvents
- Aerosol paints (spray cans)
- Auto and marine paints
- Arts and crafts paints
- Caulking compounds, epoxies, glues, adhesives
- Paint additives, colorants, tints, resins
- Wood preservatives (containing pesticides)
- Roof patch and repair
- Tar and bitumen-based products
- 2-component coatings
- Deck cleaners
- Traffic and road marking paints

Industrial Maintenance (IM) coatings

Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) (shop application) paints and finishes

Note: Leaking, unlabeled and empty containers are not accepted at drop-off sites.

Please call drop-off sites before you bring your paint to check the hours of operation and how much paint they can accept.

Illegal dumping is on the rise in Lake County and because of this a Task Force has been formed to help get information out to the community. We need to find and persuade violators to stop illegal dumping! Task Force members have found that in some cases people pay unlicensed haulers to take trash away from their properties and don't use the local landfill. Instead they find an isolated location to dump. The County of Lake is asking that you only use curbside services provided by your local franchise hauler to remove your waste. It is hazardous to the environment and personal information can be compromised. Call County of Lake Solid Waste Department at 262-1760.

PLEASE NOTE: We no longer can accept Styrofoam for recycling. Please place Styrofoam in your brown trash cart. If they are small pieces, "peanuts", place inside a trash bag and tie so Styrofoam will not litter the community. Many UPS and other shipping stores will take Styrofoam and reuse it in their shipping program, worth checking into.

South Lake Refuse & Recycling Bulky Item Pick-up Schedule

Please call to let us know you will have bulky items in advance of the listed dates, 994-8613.

Free items include: BBQ, bed frame, bicycle, box spring, carpet & padding, computer, couch, furniture, household electronics, large toys, plumbing fixtures, sporting equipment, etc. Please see our website for a complete listing.

Fee items include: \$10 fee for air conditioner, dishwasher, dryer, refrigerator or freezer, stove, oven, washing machine or water heater.

The following items are NOT ACCEPTED: Concrete, dirt, hazardous waste, paint, piano, trash, tree stumps and yard debris.

Paper



- Cardboard (must be broken down) • Boxboard (e.g. shoe boxes, cereal boxes)
- Office paper (all colors) • Magazines, catalogs & glossy paper
- Soft-cover books • Envelopes (labels or windows OK) • Newspaper
- Shredded paper in clear bags

Metal



- Aluminum cans • Tin & steel cans • Clean aluminum pans & foil
- Empty aerosol cans • Loose lids from jars • Small scrap metal
- Pots, pans & utensils

Glass



- Bottles & jars • All colors, lids removed
- Rinsed & empty (labels okay)

Plastics Rinsed & Empty



- All CRV containers accepted • All numbers accepted
- Bottles & jugs (all colors)
- Tubs & containers (e.g. margarine)
- Food service trays & deli containers

Please No: Styrofoam • Clothing and Shoes • Food or Liquids • Paper Towels • Plastic Bags

Materials we Recycle at Quackenbush Compost

Clean Green Organic Material: Green organic plant material such as (but is not limited to) tree trimmings, grass, leaves, etc. Green organics must not contain any contamination such as household trash, plastics, etc. Disposal Cost \$42.00 Per Ton. Minimum Charge \$10.00.

Clean Construction Wood: Any clean wood, nails OK. Wood that is not recyclable includes (but is not limited to) painted wood, any kind of treated wood, particle board, etc. Disposal Cost \$42.00 Per Ton. Minimum Charge \$10.00.

Clean Concrete: Concrete must be separate from soils and dirt, no rebar and 12" minus. Disposal Cost \$12.00 Per Ton. Minimum Charge \$10.00.

Concrete: Concrete must be separate from soils and dirt. Rebar OK. Disposal Cost \$18.00 Per Ton. Minimum Charge \$10.00.

Clean Asphalt: Asphalt must be separate from soils and dirt or higher charges may apply. Disposal Cost \$12.00 Per Ton. Minimum Charge \$10.00.

Clean Dirt: Any soil or dirt free of contaminants such as trash, concrete, asphalt, green waste, etc. Dispos-

al Cost \$10.00 Per Ton. Minimum Charge \$10.00.

Our facility offers blends of organically approved and listed compost, topsoil and two sizes of wood chips for your landscaping, gardening and agricultural needs. Delivery is available.

1. Quackenbush Blended Compost: Grape pomace is added to our Quackenbush compost which

increases the nutrient content of the compost. The compost has dark rich color and fine texture. The compost is screened to 3/8" minus. Price \$32.00 Per Ton, Plus Tax.

2. Quackenbush Compost: Is purely green-material compost. Composted for several months to give a rich color and a medium texture. Also screened to 3/8" minus. Price \$32.00 Per Ton, Plus Tax.

3. Topsoil: Topsoil is mixed with 60% compost and 40% soil to be extra rich in organic matter. Great for new lawns, gardens and other applications. Price \$34.00 Per Ton, Plus Tax.

4. Premium Topsoil: 5/16" lava rock is added to our regular topsoil mixture to increase the soil's porosity and increase water infiltration. Price \$38.00 Per Ton, Plus Tax.

5. Wood Chips 3/8" Minus: Finely ground and screened to 3/8" minus. Good for topdressing and mulching. Price \$30.00 Per Ton, Plus Tax.

6. Wood Chips 1": Has a golden color coarse texture and makes a good topdressing. Price \$30.00 Per Ton, Plus Tax.
